



## NASA Region VII Conference Call for Proposals

The NASA Region VII Conference will be March 5-7, 2021, hosted by Winthrop University. The programming committee is currently accepting proposals for performances, masterclasses, and lectures. All proposals must be submitted by January 8th for consideration. Accepted proposals will be announced by January 15th.

Solo and chamber performance proposals are being accepted from saxophonists from high school to professional. Performances may be a maximum of 22 minutes including all performing and talking. Follow this [link](#) to access the performance proposal application.

Masterclass proposals are being accepted for high school through graduate students. While there is no limit on the length of the piece proposed, the masterclass presenter will choose which excerpts they would like to hear. Follow this [link](#) to access the masterclass proposal application.

Lecture proposals are being accepted from undergraduate and graduate students as well as professionals. Lectures must be limited to 50 minutes including Q&A. Follow this [link](#) to access the lecture proposal application



- All performances and lectures will be given in a Zoom meeting room.
- It is strongly advised that performances are pre-recorded and streamed in the Zoom meeting to eliminate potential audio issues.
- If performers wish to give a live performance, there will not be a soundcheck provided by the NASA Regional Conference.  
If performers stream a pre-recorded performance, it is advised that they make a live appearance to discuss the piece(s).
- Masterclass sessions will be recorded in the days leading up to the conference and times will be decided by the masterclass presenter. Performers are expected to have a high-quality audio/video setup. Video will be recorded via Zoom and audio through Cleanfeed.
- Lectures are encouraged to be given live using screen-share for all visual and audio aids. The NASA Regional Conference will not provide time to do any audio/video checks.
- We recommend all performers and presenters become familiar with the Zoom platform prior to the conference. You can set up a [free account](#) that will provide access to meeting rooms where you can test all of the features.
